

## **SAP Sentinel cloud edition Supplemental Terms and Conditions**

These supplemental terms and conditions ("the Supplement") are part of an agreement for certain SAP cloud services ("Agreement") between SAP and Customer and apply solely to SAP Sentinel cloud edition (the "Cloud Service") and not to any other SAP product or service.

### **1. Cloud Service**

**1.1.** Customer may use Application Programming Interfaces (APIs) made available as part of the Cloud Service to interface applications provided by Customer to Customer's end users ("**End Users**") with the Cloud Service. Applications interfaced with Cloud Service APIs must be developed by or for Customer specifically for use by End Users. Any End User accessing or sending data via a Cloud Service API, directly or through a Customer application, is deemed an Authorized User as defined in the GTC.

**1.2.** Customer may use the Cloud Service to permit End Users to perform analysis and modeling of financial instruments and capital markets. End Users are not permitted to directly access the Cloud Service and the Cloud Service Content, but may only view results obtained through the Cloud Service APIs that are delivered through Customer's application user interface.

**1.3.** The Cloud Service requires third-party data to perform analytics and text analysis. SAP may provide certain data as part of the Cloud Service ("**Cloud Service Content**"). To the extent such data is not provided by SAP as part of the Cloud Service, or Customer requires additional data, these third-party data must be obtained by Customer directly from the third-party data provider. Customer is responsible for obtaining the required rights to use such data directly from the vendor and to upload such data into the Cloud Service for processing in accordance with this Agreement, and any such data shall be considered Customer Data. Customer may use Cloud Service APIs to upload any third party data obtained by Customer into the Cloud Service for Customer's use.

**1.4.** SAP does not verify the accuracy or authenticity of Cloud Service Content. Customer is obligated to ensure the accuracy of Cloud Service Content, and SAP is not responsible for Customer's and its End Users' use of or reliance on the analyses derived from the Cloud Service Content.

**1.5.** The Cloud Service may include one or more integrations with Third Party Web Services. "Third Party Web Services" means (i) any and all web services made available by third parties (other than SAP, SAP SE and/or any of their affiliated companies) that are accessible through or enabled by the Cloud Service and subject to a separate agreement between Customer and the third party web service provider, and (ii) any and all application programming interfaces, web service definition files, and other materials made available by or on behalf of such third party web service providers to facilitate the access to and use of such web services. Third Party Web Services are not part of the Cloud Service, and Customer is solely responsible for any use of or inability to use Third Party Web Services by Customer or its Affiliates or End Users. Customer shall comply with all vendor terms and conditions associated with the use of any Third Party Web Services.

**2. Fees.** The Usage Metric for the Cloud Service is API Calls per month. An API Call means a single call made to a Cloud Service API from Customer's application or environment.

### **3. Additional Terms.**

**1.2 Data.** Analytics Data is data generated by the Cloud Service based on developer and application access to Cloud Service APIs. Analytics Data can be accessed by Customer at any time while such data is stored in the Cloud Service.

#### **1.3 Cloud Service APIs**

**1.3.1** The Cloud Service APIs must not be used to: (i) unreasonably impair, degrade or reduce the performance or security of the Cloud Service; (ii) enable the bypassing or circumventing of SAP use restrictions and/or provide End Users with access to Cloud Service to which such End Users are not directly authorized; or (iii) permit mass data or metadata extraction from the Cloud Service to non-SAP software, including use, modification, saving or other processing of such data in the non-SAP software.

- 1.3.2** Customer is responsible for configuring applications and interfaces it uses in connection with the Cloud Service to ensure the proper integration with the Cloud Service APIs, using the API Documentation provided by SAP.
- 1.3.3** Cloud Service APIs are subject to ongoing changes as communicated by SAP subject to the terms of the GTC governing changes to the Cloud Service. It is Customer's responsibility to adapt the Customer application to such changes to Cloud Service APIs.
- 1.3.4** SAP is not responsible for any defect or malfunction in the Cloud Service caused by use of the APIs except as permitted in this Agreement.
